It's Habitat Sunday!



This morning we are pleased to welcome Rev. Lisa Lefkow, CEO of Habitat for Humanity of Collier County, who brings us a message of great joy and thanks, for this

year Emmanuel celebrates the funding of our 50th Habitat house! This means that during our 18 years of partnership with Habitat we have paid for the materials to provide safe, decent housing for over 150 less fortunate people in our community! This milestone is a record among all of the congregations of all denominations here in Collier County.

But our work is far from complete. Over 17 families have applied for *each* of the 110 houses that Habitat plans to build in 2019!

Can you help? This year our donations have been somewhat light. Thus far we have only received funds sufficient to build two Habitat homes. Materials to build a Habitat home cost \$50,000. Your donation, large or small will be much appreciated!

It's our last chance to make 2018 tax-deductible donations. And don't forget, IRA owners 70-1/2 and older can donate as much as \$100,000 of account assets directly to charity this year without it counting as income!
