K - 5th grades will meet upstairs in the Children's Ministry classroom


6th - 12th grades will meet upstairs in the Oasis

We will not have services or Sunday School on February 24, at our Alive Service and our Pebblebrooke campus due to the large number of people from those services who are attending the Family Retreat.


