


#### FLOWER MINISTRY

Unlike many cities and counties in other parts of the country, **Collier County** 

has no welfare department. Many of the hungry and homeless among us have nowhere to turn except to local charities. Nearly 1000 children in Collier County are confirmed to be homeless, and officials believe the actual number is much higher. Your donations make a difference!
