The beloved hymn, "To God Be the Glory," was written by the prolific composer Fanny Crosby (1820-1915). Although Fanny was blinded by an illness as an infant, she lived a long life full of joy and accomplishment. She wrote more than 9000 hymns during her lifetime. Many, such as "All the Way My Savior Leads Me" and "Blessed Assurance" quickly became standards. "To God Be the Glory" became well known after a Billy Graham Crusade in London in 1954. After this, the song was sung in the United States at future gatherings.
