WHY YOU SHOULD WEAR RED NEXT WEEK, JUNE 9

So what's the story on wearing RED at Pentecost? What does it represent?

In the church year, the day of Pentecost is the culmination of the 50 days of the Easter celebration. After showing himself to the disciples and after having ascended, Jesus's followers received the promised gift of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost comes from a Greek word meaning "fiftieth day." On this upcoming fiftieth day of Easter (June 9), our worship here at Emmanuel will be filled with festivity and color as we both conclude the Easter celebration and welcome anew the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Many Lutherans wear **RED** on the festival of Pentecost, recalling the **RED** of the flames of the Holy Spirit. The **RED** serves as a sign that the Holy Spirit comes to all believers.

Please consider wearing **RED** next week and help us celebrate Pentecost. (P.S.: If you do not wear **RED**, please come anyway!!!!)
