## **ABOUT TODAY'S MUSIC**

Many thanks to the Emmanuel Choir, who will be singing at the 11:00 service today. The Choir will be singing one more



week (May 13), and then will take a well-deserved break (although there will be special music throughout the summer by members of the Choir). We are so appreciative for the musical gifts you share with us.

Today's prelude, GWALCHMAI, is not a misprint! It is the name of a Welsh hymn tune. Gwalchmai is the name of a small village in northern Wales. This hymn tune was written by Henry Walford Davies in the late 1800s. Hymn tunes are named by the composer and can represent a person (BRADBURY—"Savior, like a Shepherd Lead Us"), a place (such as GWALCHMAI—"Easter Carol"), or a thing or idea (HOLY MAN-NA—"All Who Hunger, Gather Gladly"). This version of GWALCHMAI was arranged by renown American composer Richard Purvis (1913-1994). If you look in your ELW, you will notice that hymn tunes are always capitalized.
