

Habitat for Humanity

At the start of a recent Emmanuel tour of some of the slum housing here in Collier County, as well as some new Habitat devel-

opments, Emmanuel was presented a plaque, which will be mounted in the narthex. It lists the names of FIVE new grateful owners of houses funded by members of Emmanuel last year - - the most of any congregation in Collier County! This brings our total to 54 since we started partnering with Habitat.

Last year Habitat built over 90 homes here in Collier County, but 19 families applied for each house that Habitat could afford to build.

When children move from overcrowded apartments, mold-filled trailers, or complexes filled with gangs, drugs, and crime, the opportunities of the world open up to them. Thoughts once consumed by fear and hopelessness can instead focus on school and dreams for the

future. Why not consider a special Lenten or Easter gift to Habitat? \$50,000 buys all materials needed to build a house, but donations of any size are gratefully accepted! 


Please put all casseroles for St. Matthew's House in the designated freezer chest located in the kitchen. (It's across from the coffee makers.)
